Social Studies is taught through interdisciplinary topics which allow the pupils to learn in context.

Included in this would be

- People, past events and societies

- People in society, economy and business.

This cross curricular approach offers children opportunities to observe and study their surroundings: to learn the necessary skills to enable them to interpret and record information gained and to gain understanding of their environment.



Pentland pupils also get the opportunity to say what they would like to learn about under a given 'Topic'. This allows the children some choice in what they learn.
